Dear Parents/Carers

We have noticed that there has been an increase in the number of mobile phones being brought into school by pupils.

If you believe that it is absolutely essential that your child/children have a mobile phone with them because they walk to school alone, we do need to remind you of the following-:

- Mobile phones must be left with the Office Staff during the school day and will not be returned to children until the end of the day
- Any child found with a mobile phone, on school premises during the school day will have their phone removed and parents contacted.
- Any filming, photo taking or video calling found to be taking place within the school boundaries will be dealt with as a serious matter
- No personal tablets are allowed
- The School cannot be held responsible for any loss or damage to mobile phones or other devices

Please remind your child that if they carry a mobile phone on the journey to or from school that they should be aware of road safety at all times.
